Folsom Lake College is very proud of its students' successes and accomplishments! I wanted to share a few of those achievements with you now:

The college's Students In Free Enterprise (SIFE) team finished first at Regional Competition in Hollywood in April. At the competition, the team presented their 27 community-based business projects in a presentation to judges. The hard-working FLC team won high marks from the judges on the passion they expressed for their projects and the work they completed in international projects. The team then competed in the SIFE National Competition in May in Chicago, Illinois. They finished 2nd runner-up in their league; this placed them in the top 15 community college programs in the country.

FLC student Cassie Costantini was honored with selection to the Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) 2008 All-California Academic Team. Cassie is a January 2007 graduate of Horizon Charter School and has been a FLC student since 2003, taking FLC classes throughout high school. She is planning to major in Communications in order to prepare to study law and eventually attend law school. She graduated in May and is planning to transfer to UC Berkeley or UCLA.
