

## Financial Aid Deadlines 2018-19

Priority FAFSA Filing	<b>March 2, 2018</b>	<b>March 2, 2018</b>	<b>March 2, 2018</b>	Students may still submit FAFSA after this date, but priority is given on a first-come first-serve basis. Additionally, students may not be considered for Cal grant if they file after the March 2 <sup>nd</sup> Deadline.
Cal Grant GPA	<b>March 2, 2018</b>	<b>March 2, 2018</b>	<b>March 2, 2018</b>	GPA Verifications must be submitted to the California Student Aid Commission by this date for state wide Cal Grant consideration.
File Completion	June 11, 2018	November 5, 2018	May 6, 2019	To ensure students are awarded aid the first week of the semester or the first week of attendance of classes, students must turn in all required documents and meet all eligibility standards by this date.
Enrollment cut off for first payment	July 23, 2018	January 7, 2019	May 20, 2019	In addition to completing your file by the "File Completion" deadline, students must be enrolled in their courses that start at the beginning of the term to receive aid the first week of the semester. Students who add courses after this deadline may not receive payment for the courses added on the first week of classes. Students will not receive grants until the courses have started.
Cal Grant CC Deadline	<b>September 2, 2018</b>	<b>September 2, 2018</b>	<b>September 2, 2018</b>	Students who want to be considered for a Cal Grant from the California Student Aid Commission (for Community College students only) must complete a FAFSA, GPA verification, and be enrolled at a community by this date.
Cal Grant Recalculation Date (CRD)	<b>September 5, 2018</b>	<b>January 30, 2019</b>	<b>Not Applicable</b>	The amount of your Cal Grant eligibility will be based on the units you are enrolled in on this date. Students who add classes after this date will not receive a Cal Grant for the late added classes. Students who received Cal Grant funding prior to this date and dropped classes may be required to repay based on their current enrollment on this date. NO adjustments will be made after this date.
Consortium Request	October 15, 2018	March 11, 2019	June 24, 2019	Students who are attending another college within the Los Rios Community College District and want the financial aid office at your home school to consider the other college units for payment must submit a request by this date.
Pell Recalculation Date (PRD)	<b>October 21, 2018</b>	<b>March 17, 2019</b>	<b>June 30, 2019</b>	The amount of your Pell Grant eligibility will be based on the units you are enrolled in on this date. Students who add classes after this date will not receive a Pell Grant for the late added classes. Students who received Pell Grant funding prior to this date and dropped classes may be required to repay based on their current enrollment on this date. NO upward adjustments will be made after this date.
Appeal Form	November 5, 2018	April 8, 2019	July 8, 2019	Students who wish to submit a Financial Aid Appeal due to lack of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) must submit their request by this date. Requests received after this date will be considered on a case-by case basis. Failure to meet deadline will result in denial of appeal.
Loan Request	November 13, 2018	April 15, 2019	July 15, 2019	Students who wish to receive a loan must submit their request by this date. Request received after this date will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Failure to meet the deadline may result in denial of a loan.
End of the term file completion	December 20, 2018	May 22, 2019	August 8, 2019	Students seeking financial aid for the respective semester(s) should submit all requested documents by this date. Failure to complete your financial aid file by this date may forfeit your aid eligibility.

**Note: The last day to submit a 2018-2019 FAFSA to be considered for summer 2019 grants and any retro disbursements (if eligible) is June 30, 2019.**
